Expanded Itinerary

The below itinerary is provided as an example only, mother nature will be our guide. Our voyages are true expeditions, where each day's activities will be determined by the Expedition Leader and Captain taking into account the tide, weather, sea conditions and chance encounters, creating a truly memorable experience for even the most ardent of travellers.

Day 1 Wyndham, Western Australia (Embarkation): Wyndham is the northernmost town in Western Australia, serving as the gateway to the Kimberley, surrounded by spectacular landforms, rivers, and wetlands.

Days 2-3 North Kimberley Coast: Known for its gorges and waterfalls, the North Kimberley coast features stunning sandstone escarpments and ancient rock art. Iconic sites include King George Falls, Vansittart Bay, and Jar Island. Paspaley Pearl will be taking you to many known and secret locations to explore the Northern Part of the Kimberley.



Days 4-6 Bonaparte Archipelago:

A maze of islands rich in Aboriginal rock art, The Bonaparte Archipelago includes:

- Prince Frederick Harbour
- The Roe-Hunter River
- Prince Regent National Park
- Kuri Bay
- King's Cascade
- Bigge Island.

Days 7-9 Collier Bay and Camden Sound: Home to the second largest tides in the world, Collier Bay and Camden Sound feature unique tidal phenomena like Horizontal Falls and Montgomery Reef. The area is significant to the Dambeemangarddee people and hosts the world's largest population of migrating humpback whales.



Day 10 Buccaneer Archipelago: Stretching from the Dampier Peninsula, this area includes 800 islands, renowned for birdlife and breeding Green Sea turtles. Iconic sites are the Lacepede Islands, Yampi Sound, and Cape Leveque.

Day 11 Broome, Western Australia (Disembarkation): Broome, known as the pearl of North West Australia, is the coastal gateway to the Kimberley and home to the famous white sands of Cable Beach. Disembarkation will commence at the wharf in Broome.
